NOTICE OF RACE (Revised March 23, 2008)

1. Rules

This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing and the Class Rules of the Olson 30 Class Association and the Sailing Instructions.

2. Advertising

Advertising will be restricted to Category C.

3. Entries

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all yachts of the Olson 30 Class that have active and paid up skippers 30 days before the beginning of the 2008 National Championship.
- 3.2. Entries for the National Championship should be made through the attached Entry Form and sent to Channel Islands Yacht Club, 4100 Harbor Blvd., Oxnard, CA 93035, mailed by June 20, 2008. Completed Entry Forms shall be sent with payment in full, Attention: Olson 30 Nationals Event Coordinator.
- 3.3. The entry fee is USD \$180. Payment constitutes confirmation of the entry and is non-refundable.
- 3.4. The entry fee includes racing and trophies.
- 3.5. Late entries may be accepted at the competitors meeting at Channel Islands Yacht Club on the first day of racing. 17th July 2008 However, no late entries will be accepted if the boat has not been weighed and measured, and if the sails have not been stamped.

4. Eligibility

Fully paid up members of the Olson 30 Class Association thirty (30) days prior to the first race.

6. Measurement

Regatta Officials will measure and/or stamp all sails. Random inspections for class safety rules may be conducted at any time during the regatta. See schedule for measurement times. All boats will be weighed and keel positions will be measured.

7. Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions shall be available at registration and will be posted on the CIYC and Olson 30 web sites.

8. Venue

9.1 The regatta site is Channel Islands Yacht Club, 4100 Harbor Blvd., Oxnard, CA 93035, Phone: 805-985-2492 / Fax: 805-985-2942.

9.2 The racing area will be outside the Channel Islands Harbor Detached Breakwater.

9. Courses

The courses will be windward-leeward as shown in the sailing instructions.

10. Scoring

12.1 The low point scoring system, RRS Appendix A2 scoring system will apply. There are nine races scheduled. There will be one throw-out,

12.2 Three races completed shall constitute a championship regatta.

12.3 If fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

12. Haul-Out Restrictions

Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with prior written permission of the race committee. Underwater cleaning of hulls will be allowed.

13. Prizes

Perpetual trophies will be awarded to each skipper placing first, second, third, fourth and fifth in the regatta. "Keeper" trophies will also be awarded to the first 5 places.

14. Additional Information

Lunches and breakfasts will be available at the CIYC clubhouse. Lunches must be ordered in advance and purchased through the office at CIYC. A full schedule of social events will be made available in the competitors race packets.

15. Lodging

Lodging with local Sailors is available on a first come, first serve basis, or at local hotels.
