1. Rules

- 1.1. This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. RRS 63.7 will be replaced with: "If there is any conflict between the sailing instructions and this notice of race, the sailing instructions shall apply."

2. Advertising

- 2.1. Advertising will be restricted to category C.

3. Entries

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all Olson 30s, as defined in the class constitution and by-laws.
- 3.2. Entries for the National Championship should be made through the attached entry form and sent to Cabrillo Beach Yacht Club, 211 W. 22nd Street, San Pedro, CA 90731.
- 3.3. The entry fee is \$200
- 3.4. Completed entry forms with payment must be postmarked no later than June 1, 2009.
- 3.5. Late entries may be accepted at the sole discretion of the class president.

4. Eligibility

- 4.1. The regatta is defined in the class constitution and by-laws.

6. Measurement

- 6.1. Class officials will measure and/or stamp all sails.
- 6.2. Entrants are responsible for completing the measurement process
- 6.3. Random inspections for class safety rules may be conducted at any time during the regatta.

7. Sailing Instructions

- 7.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration and may be available at the CBYC website

8. Venue

8.1. The racing area may be inside or outside the Federal Breakwater in the vicinity of Angel's Gate Lighthouse in the Port of Los Angeles.

9. Courses

9.1. Courses will be chosen from a course chart included with the Sailing Instructions

10. Scoring

10.1. The low point scoring System, RRS Appendix A2 will apply.

10.2. Three races completed shall constitute a championship regatta.

10.3. If fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

11. Haul-out Restrictions

11.1. Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with prior written permission of the race committee. Underwater cleaning of hulls will be allowed.

12. Prizes

12.1. Perpetual trophies will be awarded 1st-5th overall.

13. Additional Information

13.1. Lunches will be available at the CBYC clubhouse, but must be ordered in advance.

13.2. Dinner service and the CBYC bar will be available after racing each day.

14. Lodging

14.1. Lodging may be available with local sailors – please call Commodore Aaron Feves at 310.293.8097 for information.
